Dr. Bikram Singh Virk started efforts to improve the appearance of the college as soon as he assumed the post as the college principal. Under the leadership of the College Principal Sahib, many important works were carried out through various committees formed to improve the image of the college, the details of which are as follows:

- Paint work was done in the college campus. With the painting of all the rooms, doors, windows of the college, a new clean look of the entire college building emerged.
- Due to subsidence, the major road entering of the college from the main gate was broken in certain areas. In addition to being reconstructed by raising it, this major thoroughfare also received stronger interlocking tile edging for greater visibility.
- With the support of the Forest Department, 15 solar lights were installed at different places to improve the lighting system in the college campus.
- Three new direction boards have been installed at different places to inform the students enrolled in the college and their parents about the direction of the principal office, college office and various important departments.
- Notice boards used to inform the students studying in the college about various activities taking place in the college have also been newly installed.
- Roof repairs were carried out to remove the problem of water leakage from the old roofs of various departments.
- Sign boards with new bright lights were installed at the main gate of the college.
- Various lawns, botanical gardens of the college were planted with new plants, grass and flowers. In the spring, blooming flowers and greenery everywhere add to the beauty of the college.
- Two new bathrooms for male and female staff members were constructed in the staff room of the college.
- In addition to the girls' common room, separate bathrooms were also given a new looking by installing new floor tiles both for boys and girls,.
- The colorful college sign plan placed near the main road leading into the college attracts everyone.
- A new gym was Installed by the sports department of the college for the students.
- Vehicle parking for the staff members of the college was constructed. A new shed was built in the parking lot.

Sports

The students of the college do not only shine in the academic field but also excel in the field of sports. Due to the contribution of the hardworking teachers of the sports department of the college, the outstanding achievements in the field of sports are as follows-

- Open Punjab State Cross Country was held at Nawan Sahah on 14/12/2021 in which G.K.S.M. Government College Tanda cross country team Secured second position in Punjab. College B. A. Third semester student Lakshdeep Singh, Akash Nagpal B. A. Third Semester, Naatjit Singh and Ajay Kumar of B.A. Semester I, Sharandeep Kaur and Tarandeep Kaur secured individual positions.

- In the open state championship organized by Colonel Sharpshooter Academy Jalandhar and Punjab Kesari from 18-08-21 to 21-08-2021, the college student Ankita brought laurel to the college by getting silver medal in 10 meter air pistol competition.
- In the "Shaheed Bhagat Singh Open State Taekwondo Championship" held at Chandigarh University, Kharar from 1 to 3 October 2021 by the Punjab Taekwondo Jalandhar Association, in which our college student Sonia, of B. A. Part III, bagged a bronze medal in the 50Kg weight category.
- In the 6th Himalayan Cup Open National Taekwondo Championship 2022 held at Manali, Himachal Pradesh from 26th February to 28th February 2022, our college student Sonia won bronze medal in 55kg weight category.
- In the Inter College Championship 2021-22 organized by Punjab University Chandigarh on March 13 to 14, 2022, the Cross Country Team of the college won the bronze medal.

NCC

The college offers a three-year NCC course to help students develop their overall personalities. Every year, Major Gurmeet Singh, the capable course director for this three-year NCC programme, welcomes 110 new cadets (including boys and girls). All camps organised by the officers are eagerly attended by NCC Officers and Cadets at the battalion, group, directorate, and national levels. During the 2021–2022 session. The following are the activities of the wing:

1. 6 NCC Cadets were selected for the Republic Day Camp. 15 cadets selected for Directorate Level Camp conducted in Ropar. Among them Ms. Harpreet Kaur, a student of B.Sc. Part II, showed good performance in the parade to be held on Rajpath on 26 January 2022 and Ashispal, a student of B. A. Part III participated in the cultural program.
2. 30 NCC cadets appeared for 'C' certificate and 20 cadets appeared for 'B' certificate.
3. 29 cadets and NCC Officer participated in CATC (Combined Annual Training camp) organized at Lyallpur Khalsa College Jalandhar and 22 cadets participated in CATC organized at Lovely Professional University, Jalandhar.
4. NCC Cadets under Community Development Program planted more than 200 trees in Army Ground Tanda and College Campus.
5. NCC cadets cleaned the college campus and army grounds as part of the community service cleanup campaign.
6. NCC Officers and all cadets also received online certificate training to educate them about Covid-19.

Zonal Youth Festival

As per the instruction of respected Honorable Secretary of Higher Education Department Mr. Krishna Kumar (IAS) and under the able leadership of College Principal Dr. Bikram Singh Virk the details of the important activities conducted in the college during this session are as follows-

1. Alumni Meet - Many students who have graduated from the college are still associated with the college while working in different positions in different departments. In order to refresh the memories of these old students and to get suggestions for the further improvement of the college, an alumni meet was held in the college on 16 February 2022 and 12 March 2022, in which the old students were informed about the new reforms and works done in the college, valuable suggestions were also received regarding other improvements that could be made in the college.

2. Sports Meet - Annual Sports Meet was organized on 24th March 2022 at the College Sports Ground by the Sports Department of the College as an effort to connect maximum number of students with sports. The morning session of which was inaugurated by the college principal Dr. Bikram Singh Virk . In this annual sports event, 100m, 200m, 400m; 800 m., 1500 m. Apart from the race of 4 × 100 m. Relay race, long jump, high jump, shot put events were also conducted. The second session of the evening was inaugurated by Honorable M.L.A. of Tanda Urmur. A. S. Jasveer Singh Raja Gill did. Prizes were given to students who won in various sports competitions. In the prize distribution ceremony held at the end of the event, apart from the first, second and third place players, coaches who coached these players, was also honored with a memento.

3. Inauguration of computer building - The newly constructed computer building in the college under RUSA grant was inaugurated on October 16, 2021 by the Minister of Forest Department and Labor Department. Sangat Singh Giljani did. Students will be given computer training in this newly constructed building.

4. Webinar and Seminar organized by the Department of Commerce - A webinar was organized by the Department of Commerce on 17 November 2021 on the subject of Communication Building Activities in which resource person Prof. Sadaf Tahir from IIM Business School Navi Mumbai gave a lecture on the topic. In this webinar, he informed the students about how to present them while going for an interview in any institution/organization. On March 17, 2022, a seminar was organized by the Department of Commerce in collaboration with Chandigarh University on the subject of "Global Career Option" in the college campus. In which the students were given information about the jobs available in various institutions.

5. Formation of Punjabi Bhasha Manch- Punjabi Bhasha Manch Tanda was established on January 10, 2022 by Punjabi Department for the promotion and dissemination of Punjabi language. In which, apart from various professors, some students were selected as office bearers, while the rest of the students will work as members of the forum. All the members of this language forum will work as a team for the development of Punjabi language, Punjabi mother tongue and Punjabi literature.

6. International Mother Language Day- The Punjabi department of the college under took an oath to promote the mother tongue Punjabi on the occasion of International Mother Language Day on 21 February 2022.

7. Two-day training workshop by Agriculture department - Agriculture department participated in a two-day training workshop at village Shahbazpur, Tanda Urmur on 18th and 19th March 2022 to give information about honey bee rearing and honey extraction to the students. In this training workshop, the students learned the methods of rearing honey bees and extracting the honey collected by the bees.

8. Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat - Under the Government of India's program 'Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat', the 'Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat Club' was also formed in Government College Tanda. Incharge of this club Prof. Deepak Kapoor. Various activities are to be organized by this club every month throughout the year. Due to the connection of the state of Punjab with the state of Andhra Pradesh, the students of Punjab are being given information about the geographical location of Andhra Pradesh, folk dances, famous historical places and language. 2. Certificate Course in Mushroom Cultivation

10+ 2 Pass students in any stream and degree holder students can also take admission in these courses. Students can take this course while pursuing their degree for a low fee.

11. Coordination with various government schools of the area to increase enrollment in government colleges- As per orders received from the higher education department officials, various teams were sent to the schools to coordinate with nearby government senior secondary schools of the area to increase enrollment in the college. The students of 10+2 were given information regarding various subjects and courses being taught in the college.

12. Dastak Program- Dastak program has been started to give information or suggestions to the college students about the problem occurring at the college level, under which any student can directly contact the college principal to give information about the problem occurring at the college level or to give any suggestion for the improvement of the college. Students can meet the Principal on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM.

Celebrated Occasions

1. Activities related to the 400th birth centenary of Sri Guru Teg Bahadur Ji - Various activities were conducted in the college throughout the year to celebrate the 400th birth centenary of Shri Guru Teg Bahadur ji as per the guidelines received by the Punjab Government and the Department of Higher Education. 4. 15th August (Independence Day) - On 15th August 2021, the 74th Independence Day celebrations were celebrated in the college with full enthusiasm. On this occasion, the flag hoisting ceremony was done by College Principal Dr. Bikram Singh Virk. The students of the music department colored the entire atmosphere in the color of patriotism by singing the national anthem and patriotic songs.
