


5.3.2 Average number of sports and cultural programs in which students of the Institution participated during last five years (organised by the institution/other institutions)


- **Participation:** Sonia from our college participated in the event, representing our institution with pride and determination.
- **Achievement:** Sonia demonstrated exceptional skill and perseverance, securing a bronze medal in the competition.






Event: Poem Recitation (Zoom Meet) on Janam Shatabdi Guru Teg Bahadur Ji





Zonal Phase: Twenty-three students actively participated, contributing vibrant cultural performances and exhibits.






Event: Inter College University Competition (Athletics)






Event: Inter College University Competition (Shooting)



- **Achievement:** Sonia demonstrated exceptional skill and perseverance, secured a bronze medal in the competition.






Event: Inter College University Competition (Cross Country Men)


