In our institution, the walkways were made to be wide enough to comfortably fit pedestrians. Make sure they are wherever feasible isolated from motor traffic, well-lit, and well marked. In order to survive weather conditions and create a safe walking surface, construction materials that are robust and nonslip were employed. Accessible routes are available for people with disabilities as well. Include curb cuts, tactile paving, and ramps to facilitate wheelchair users and anyone who have mobility issues. Observe accessibility standards to create a welcoming environment for all campus visitors.
